SECOND NOTICE OF HEARING

This refers to the Application for Third Amendment of Certificate of Public Convenience filed by Applicant on 12 December 2013, for the ship, **M/Tug "TRABAJADOR 1"**.

Records show that an Order dated 18 December 2013 was issued by this Authority setting the case for hearing on 07 January 2014, at 10:00 o'clock in the morning. The said Order was received by Applicant's representative on 19 December 2013 as per records of this Office.

On 06 January 2013, Applicant's Counsel filed a Motion requesting for re-setting of hearing in view of the late receipt of the previously issued NOH and requested that the hearing be re-set to 22 January 2014. According to the Applicant's Counsel, the NOH was only forwarded to it on 02 January 2014, giving said Counsel insufficient time to comply with the required time of publication or posting of the Notice of Hearing (NOH) which is ten (10) days prior to the scheduled date of hearing of the Application on 07 January 2014.

WHEREFORE, finding the request to be meritorious, let the case be re-set for hearing on **22 January 2014, at 10:00 o'clock in the morning** at the Franchising Office (FO), Hearing Room, Room 306, 3rd Floor, Parkview Plaza, (Masagana Telamart, Inc.) 984 Taft Ave., Cor. T.M. Kalaw St., Ermita, Manila.

The Applicant shall cause the publication of this Order once in any of the newspapers of general circulation or posting thereof in the MARINA website, at least ten (10) days before the scheduled hearing.

The Applicant shall likewise furnish a copy of its Application and this Order at least five (5) days before the scheduled hearing to the affected parties, namely:

1. United Trampers Association of the Philippines (UTAP); and,
2. Concerned Metro Manila Tugboat, Barge and LCT Owners Association.

Parties opposed to the grant of the Application must file their written opposition supported by documentary evidence on or before the above date, furnishing a copy of the same to the Applicant, and may, if they so desire, appear on said date and time.

The Applicant shall be required to make a written Formal Offer of Evidence (FOE) during the hearing or five (5) days thereafter.
