NOTICE OF HEARING

This is a petition for approval of sale and transfer of the ship named **MV "GRAND STAR RORO 1"** and change of name to **MV "REGINA CALIXTA VI"** filed on 26 February 2014 by the herein Petitioner-Vendor of legal age, married, Filipino, with postal address at 704/705 Royal Twin Tower R 648 Remedios St., Malate, Manila.

Petitioner-Vendor sold the subject ship to **REGINA SHIPPING LINES, INC.**, represented by **JOSEPH C. CUA**, Petitioner-Vendee, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Philippines, with principal office address at Capilihan, Virac, Catanduanes evidence of the aforesaid conveyance is a copy of Deed of Absolute Sale dated **23 October 2013**.

This Petition will be heard by this Authority on **17 March 2014, Monday at 2:30 PM**, at the Hearing Room, Maritime Industry Authority, and Regional Office No. V, 2/F RDC Primeland Inc. Bldg., Landco Business Park, Legazpi City, at which the herein applicant shall be allowed to present its documentary evidences, after proof of compliance with the jurisdictional requirements has been complied with.

Parties opposed to this subject Petition must file their opposition in writing before this Office, within five (5) days from receipt hereof, and the same shall likewise be supported by documentary evidences, furnishing a copy thereof to the applicant.

Before the start of the hearing proper, the parties will be called to a pre-hearing conference by the Hearing Officer on the dated of the initial hearing and thereafter, for the purpose stated in R.A. 9295 the Rules of Practice Instituting Summary Procedures, MARINA Memorandum Circular No. 74 dated 14 January 1993. Parties who failed to appear at a Pre-Trial Conference, when directed to do so, may be declared non-suited by dismissing the Petition or as in default, in case of presence of their counsels unless the latter have special attorney to stipulate in the Pre-Trial Conference.

The Petitioner shall cause the publication of this Notice of Hearing at least **TEN (10) DAYS** prior to the date of hearing (and in case of the vessel operating in the region, publication in a newspaper of a regional circulation is deemed sufficient) and serve a copy of this Notice of Hearing and this application to all parties which appeared to be affected by this application (see attached list). Proof of compliance of publication of Notice of Hearing and service of compliance of publication of Notice of Hearing and service pleadings at affected parties is pre-requisite to pre-trial conference.
