SUBJECT : INVITATION TO THE REVIEW AND REVISION OF THE PHILIPPINE MERCHANT MARINE RULES AND REGULATIONS (PMMRR) 1997

In line with our thrust to come up with a comprehensive regulation for the maritime industry, the Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA) has created a Task Force to undertake a review and revision of Philippine Merchant Marine Rules and Regulations (PMMRR) 1997.

For this purpose, eight (8) Technical Working Groups (TWGs) have been created to wit:

1. Ship Building/Ship Repair/ Ship Conversion;
2. Ship Safety and Occupational Safety/Health/Environment;
3. Manpower Development [Maritime Education, Training and Certification];
4. Domestic Shipping (RoRo/Wooden Hulled);
5. Overseas Shipping (Flag Registry);
6. Fishing Vessels;
7. Pleasure Craft/Special Vessels/Tourism Application; and,
8. Off-shore Vessels.
