
SUBJECT: WARNING ON THE DANGERS OF STRAYING INTO THE
TERRITORIAL WATERS OF INDONESIA AND SULAWESI
SEA AND PROHIBITION OF ILLEGAL FISHING

Notice is hereby given that Philippine Embassy in Jakarta and the Office of the Philippine Defense Attaché in Jakarta wish to remind the owners and operators of Philippine registered fishing vessels and fishermen of the dangers of straying into Indonesian territory especially in the Sulawesi area as the Indonesian Government has taken a hard-line approach in illegal fishing, even blowing up seized fishing vessels.

It is further informed that the crackdown on illegal foreign fishing vessels within its maritime domain is one of the key elements of Indonesia's "Global Maritime Fulcrum" strategy in order to revitalise its domestic fishing industry.

In view thereof, all owners/operators of Philippine registered fishing vessels are hereby directed to issue a notice of warning to their Masters and fisher folks to avoid straying into the territorial waters of Indonesia and refrain from engaging in such prohibited acts.
