## MARINA ADVISORY NO. 2017-25

**TO :** ALL DOMESTIC SHIPOWNERS/OPERATORS ENGAGED IN THE TRANSPORT OF PASSENGERS AND ALL CONCERNED,

**SUBJECT :** FURTHER DEFERMENT OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MARINA CIRCULAR NO. 2016-01 ON THE REVISED RULES ON THE MANDATORY PASSENGER INSURANCE COVERAGE; EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE TO SURVIVORS OF MARITIME ACCIDENTS/INCIDENTS; AND OTHER RELEVANT CONCERNS


In view of the development and ongoing refinement of the draft Master Policy required by and pursuant to MARINA Circular No. 2016-01, which imposes upon the shipowners and/or operators to include in their insurance coverage for passengers the additional amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php 50,000.00) as a reimbursable emergency assistance to survivors appearing in the Passenger Manifest, that is over and above the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP 200,000.00) insurance coverage per passenger who are casualties of maritime accident/incident, implementation of the said Circular is hereby further deferred until subsequent notice.

The P200,000 insurance coverage per passenger shall remain in force as a requirement that must be complied with by the shipowners/operators for their CPC application, pursuant to Section 14.1, Rule V of the 2014 Amendments to the Revised Rules and Regulations Implementing Republic Act No. 9295.

In view of the above, all shipowners and/or operators are directed to coordinate with their respective insurers on the subject hereof.

This Advisory shall take effect immediately upon its publication.
