SUBJECT : SUSPENSION OF MARINA CIRCULAR NO. 2017-05

In response to various issues and concerns relating to the implementation of MARINA Circular No. 2017-05 entitled "*Revised Rules and Regulations on the Implementation of the Mandatory and Other Services on-board Ships Carrying Passengers in the Inter-island Shipping Trade*", notice is hereby given that the implementation of said circular is held in abeyance pending further instructions from the MARINA Board as resolved during the 254th Regular Meeting last 14 February 2018.

Accordingly, the issuance/renewal of Certificate of Compliance (COC) shall be in accordance with the provisions of MARINA Memorandum Circular No. 65 of 1991.

This Advisory shall take effect immediately after publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
