SUBJECT : ISSUANCE OF PROVISIONAL DOMESTIC CERTIFICATE OF
COMPETENCY (D-COC)

DATE : 17 October 2012

Notice is hereby given that all holders of Qualification Document Certificate which are expiring or has expired from 01 October 2012 to 30 June 2013, shall be issued a Provisional DCOC, valid for one (1) year from the date of issuance.

The Provisional DCOC shall be issued to provide ample time for domestic officers and ratings to comply with the additional training requirements and to enable shipping companies / shipowners / operators to program/schedule the training of their officers and crew, without jeopardizing ship's safety.

Fees and charges under Section VII of MARINA Circular No. 2012-04 shall apply. However, it is understood that no payment shall be required when renewal is made upon expiration of the Provisional DCOC and issuance of DCOC valid for the remaining four(4) years.

This Advisory shall take effect immediately.
