**SUBJECT : TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF THE LIMITATION UNDER
MARINA MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2011-04 FOR
HIGHLY SPECIALIZED FOREIGN REGISTERED SHIPS
OPERATING IN THE NATIONAL TERRITORY**

Pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 474, Executive Order No. 125, as amended, Sec. 6, Chapter III of the Republic Act No. 9295 and Sec. 6, Rule III of its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (R-IRR), the application of the following requirements/limitations/provisions of MARINA Memorandum Circular No. 2011-04 are hereby temporarily suspended:

“Item IV (General Provisions), par. (6), and Item V (Specific Provisions), par. (3)”

- The two-year maximum duration of Special Permit granted to “other types of foreign ships”, in particular to the highly specialized ships”.

Further, as directed by the MARINA Board, the MARINA shall immediately conduct a comprehensive review of existing policies, laws, rules and regulations in consultation with all concerned stakeholders including national and local government agencies and instrumentalities, and thereafter submit to the MARINA Board a report within one (1) year from effectivity hereof .

All other provisions of MARINA Memorandum Circular No. 2011-04 insofar as they are not inconsistent with this advisory, shall remain in full force and effect.

This MARINA Advisory shall take effect immediately.
