SUBJECT : CONDUCT OF THE "TRAIN THE SIMULATOR TRAINER AND ASSESSOR COURSE" (IMO MODEL COURSE 6.10) BY THE MARITIME INDUSTRY AUTHORITY (MARINA) AND THE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION (CHED), IN COOPERATION WITH THE MARITIME ACADEMY OF ASIA AND THE PACIFIC (MAAP)

With reference to the commitment of the Maritime Industry Authority as the single maritime administration responsible for the implementation and enforcement of the STCW Convention, as amended, the MARINA in full cooperation with CHED and MAAP shall be conducting the "TRAIN THE SIMULATOR TRAINER AND ASSESSOR COURSE" (IMO MODEL COURSE 6.10). This forms part of the Administration-approved requirements for simulator instructors and assessors.

The above course will be provided for FREE. MAAP, however, will collect a minimal amount of P300 per day to cover all the meals and P200 per night for the lodging, for a total of P1,800 only.

Said endeavor intends to augment the capacity of the faculty members of the CHED approved MHEIs to fully comply with the CMO Nos. 31 and 32, series of 2013.
