**Subject** : **OFFICIAL CLOSURE OF SEVERAL SEAPORTS IN UKRAINE**

Please be informed that as per Note Verbale No. 6124/35-327/2-950 dated 21 July 2014 issued by the Embassy of Ukraine in the United Kingdom of Great Britain, several seaports in the cities of Yevpatoria, Feodosia, Yalta, Kerch and Sevastopol in Ukraine were officially closed beginning 15 July 2014 until the restoration of the constitutional order in Ukraine. Further, please be advised that Ukrainian Embassy emphasized the possible criminal liabilities that may be faced by the shipowners and ship masters, among others, for violation of the provisions of the Ukraine legislation relative to the entry to the closed seaports of Ukraine in the territory of the Autonomous Republic of Crimea.
