

INVITATION TO BID

PROCUREMENT OF 2022 JANITORIAL SERVICES FOR THE MARINA CENTRAL AND SATELLITE OFFICES

- 1. The MARITIME INDUSTRY AUTHORITY (MARINA), through the 2022 General Appropriations Act (GAA), intends to apply the sum of Eight Million Four Hundred Thousand Pesos (P8,400,000.00), inclusive of all government taxes and other charges, being the Approved Budget of the Contract (ABC) for the Project: Procurement of 2022 Janitorial Services for the MARINA Central and Satellite Offices. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
- 2. **MARINA** now invites bids for the said Project.Contract shall commence from the approval of Contract of Agreement and issuance of Notice to Proceed.
- 3. **Bidder's Qualifications** (in addition to the provisions of RA 9184 and its IRR):
 - The Bidders must be compliant with the DOLE Department Order No. 18-A, s. 2011 in particular: Place of Work, Compliance with Labor Standards and Occupational Health and Safety, and Administrative Fee;
 - The bidders must have at least three (3) client's satisfaction ratingfrom a government agency or a private corporation with whom the bidder had contract for the past two (2) years or on-going; and
 - The bidders must have no pending case(s) against the government.
- 4. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act."
 - Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183 and subject to Commonwealth Act 138.
- 5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders from the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents pursuant to the latest guidelines issued by the GPPB.
- 6. It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and at www.marina.gov.ph provided that Bidders shall pay the non-refundable fee of Ten Thousand Pesos (₱10,000.00) only for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.
- 7. **MARINA** will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on 07 February 2022 at the MARINA Board Room, 3rd Floor MARINA Building, A. Bonifacio Drive corner 20th Street, Port Area, Manila which shall be open to all prospective bidders but shall be

- limited to only one (1) representative, per bidder, in observance of social distancing.
- 8. Bid submission and opening shall be strictly observed based on the schedule below. Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders limited to only one representative, who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.
