


MARITIME INDUSTRY AUTHORITY SITUATION REPORT -744

Passenger and Cargo Shipping Operations on 4/6/2022 in areas under Alert Level 1 & 2 Data generated on 4/6/2022, 3:00:00 PM

HIGHLIGHTS

- Ninety-Nine percent (99%) of passenger and cargo shipping operations were completed in accordance with the ships' CPC.
- One percent (1%) of the shipping operations were affected.
- Operations of passenger ships were more affected compared to cargo ships. 100% of the cargo shipping operations were completed under normal conditions compared to passenger ships at 98%.
- With cargo shipping still operational, transport of goods is assured.




PASSENGER AND CARGO SHIPPING OPERATIONS IN THE PHILIPPINES

I. STATUS OF SHIPPING OPERATIONS NATIONWIDE



On 4/6/2022, there were 106 passenger and cargo shipping operations conducted wherein 105 or 99% were completed in accordance with their Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC).

Out of the 105 operations completed under normal conditions, the reported movements were mostly in the Eastern Visayas Region at 47% and Bicol Region at 30%.

One (1) passenger ship or 3% encountered delays.

Lastly, no shipping operations were not completed at the time of reporting.



II. STATUS OF SHIPPING OPERATIONS BY CLASSIFICATION

Based on the above table , 66 out of 66 (100%) cargo ships still operated normally – are, 7 LCT ships, 59 Roro cargo ships.

Thirty – nine (39) passenger ships completed their voyage – 24 conventional passenger ships, 8 RoPax ships and 7 fast craft ferry completed their operations but mostly only carried cargoes during their voyage.

Meanwhile out of the 40 passenger ships, 3% were either by cancellation, delay, or uncompleted operations of 1 passenger ships.
