Termination of exceptional measures on validity of Seafarers' certificates under Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak

Japan has taken the necessary measures circulated as IMO Circular Letter No.4262 of 14 April 2020 (annex) to address the emergent situation that seafarers face the challenges in completing courses required for the revalidation of Certificates of Competency (COCs), Certificates of Proficiency (COPs) and endorsement, or taking medical examinations under coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak.

Taking into account the current situation that the above-mentioned challenges related to COVID-19 are being improved, Maritime Bureau, Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism of Japan has decided to terminate the exceptional measures as follows.

1. COC and Endorsement

The exceptional measure, which had been circulated as the above-mentioned Circular Letter, ended on 31 March 2023.

2. COP and Medical Certificate

The exceptional measure, which had been circulated as the above-mentioned Circular Letter, ended on 28 February 2023.
