TRANSFER OF DOMESTIC-CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY (D-COC) PROCESSING TO SEAFARERS' CERTIFICATION AND DOCUMENTATION DIVISION (SCDD) OF THE MANPOWER

DEVELOPMENT SERVICE (MDS)
