**REVOCATION OF MARINA ADVISORY NO. 2021-62** 

<u>NOTICE</u> is hereby given to all concerned that **MARINA Advisory No 2021-62** on Measures in Ensuring Safety of Ships Under MARINA Circular No. MS 2020-01 is hereby revoked subject to the following conditions:

- All incoming applications for the issuance of Certificate of Ship Survey under MARINA Advisory No. 2021-62 shall no longer be accepted after the effectivity of this Advisory;
- All applications received by MARINA before the issuance of this Advisory shall still be processed and issued with Certificate of Ship Survey, if warranted;
- All Certificate of Ship Survey shall remain valid until its expiration date or the next scheduled survey whichever comes first;
- 4. All concerned entities with existing valid Full-term Class Certificate from the former MARINA Accredited Classification Society under MC 165, may still be reissued by the same MARINA Accredited Classification Society under MC MS 2020-01, as amended, using the same validity. All ships records of survey from MARINA as per MA 2021-62 shall be incorporated in the Class Survey Report;
- All concerned entities are given ninety (90) days to ensure the smooth transfer of all ship's records to a preferred MARINA Accredited Classification Society under MC MS 2020-01, as amended;
- Notwithstanding the ninety day-period given above, ALL ships covered herein shall at all times possess a valid Class Certificate or a valid MARINA Certificate of Ship Survey.

This Advisory shall take effect immediately.
