GUIDANCE CONCERNING THE REQUIREMENTS FOUND IN THE RELEVANT INTERNATIONAL INSTRUMENTS THAT

ARE "TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE ADMINISTRATION"

In line with MARINA's responsibilities and obligations to implement policies through issuing national guidelines and pursuant to Administrative Order No. 41-21 entitled "Guidance on Interpretations regarding Implementation of International Statutory Requirements which contains To The Satisfaction of the Administration" as amended by Administrative Order No. 01-23 entitled "Guidance Concerning the Requirements Found in the Relevant International Instruments that are To The Satisfaction of the Administration", all concerned are hereby advised to strictly comply with the guidance concerning the requirements found in the relevant IMO instruments that are "to the satisfaction of the Administration".

The guidance covers the following relevant IMO instruments which provide requirements that are "to the satisfaction of the Administration and shall apply to all Philippine Registered Ships engage in International Voyage, attached as annexes hereof:

- ANNEX 1 International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS), 1974 and its Protocol 1988, as amended;
- ANNEX 2 International Convention on Load Lines (ICLL), 1966 and its Protocol of 1988, as amended;
- ANNEX 3 International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution from Ships (MARPOL 73/78) and its Protocol of 1997, as amended; and
- ANNEX 4 Convention on the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (COLREG), 1972
