
HIGHLIGHTS

- With cargo shipping still operational, transport of goods is assured.



I. STATUS OF SHIPPING OPERATIONS NATIONWIDE



On 7/29/2023, there were 10 passenger and cargo shipping operations conducted wherein 10 or 100% were completed in accordance with their Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC).

Out of the 10 operations completed under normal conditions, the reported movements were mostly in the National Capital Region at 50% and Calabarzon Region at 20%.

No shipping operations were not completed at the time of reporting.
