
HIGHLIGHTS

- Ninety-Two percent (92%) of passenger and cargo shipping operations were completed in accordance with the ships' CPC.
- Eight percent (8%) of the shipping operations were affected.
- Operations of passenger ships were more affected compared to cargo ships. 100% of the cargo shipping operations were completed under normal conditions compared to passenger ships at 87%.
- **With cargo shipping still operational, transport of goods is assured.**

PASSENGER AND CARGO SHIPPING IN NUMBERS 7/16/2022



I. STATUS OF SHIPPING OPERATIONS NATIONWIDE



On 7/16/2022, there were 25 passenger and cargo shipping operations conducted wherein 23 or 92% were completed in accordance with their Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC).

Out of the 23 operations completed under normal conditions, the reported movements were mostly in the Eastern Visayas Region at 65% and National Capital Region at 17%.

Two (2) passenger ships or 13% encountered delays.

No shipping operations were not completed at the time of reporting.



Based on the above table , 10 out of 10 (100%) cargo ships still operated normally – are 1 chemical tanker, 1 container ships, 3 LCT ships, , 5 Roro cargo ships cargo.


Thirteen (13) passenger ships completed their voyage – 6 conventional passenger ships, 5 RoPax ships and 2 fast craft ferry completed their operations but mostly only carried cargoes during their voyage.

Meanwhile out of the 15 passenger ships, 13% were affected by the measures adopted in view of COVID-19. These measures caused either the cancellation, delay, or uncompleted operations of 2 passenger ships.



Ship Operations**


