

INVITATION TO BID FOR PROCUREMENT OF 2023 SECURITY SERVICES FOR THE MARINA CENTRAL OFFICE AND ITS SATELLITE OFFICES THROUGH EARLY PROCUREMENT

- 1. The MARITIME INDUSTRY AUTHORITY, through the 2023 General Appropriations Act (GAA) intends to apply the sum of Thirteen Million Pesos (Php 13,000.000.00) being the ABC to payments under the contract for PROCUREMENT OF 2023 SECURITY SERVICES FOR THE MARINA CENTRAL OFFICE AND ITS SATELLITE OFFICES THROUGH EARLY PROCUREMENT, with identification number 2022-10-544. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
- 2. The MARITIME INDUSTRY AUTHORITY now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Delivery of the Goods is required by Section VI. Schedule of Requirements. Bidders must be engaged in the business for at least Five (5) years from the date of the bid opening. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
- 3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "*pass/fail*" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.

- 4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from MARINA Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) Secretariat and inspect the Bidding Documents at the MARINA website and the address given below from Monday to Friday, 09:00 A.M. to 04:00 P.M.
- 5. It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and at <u>www.marina.gov.ph</u>, however, the Bidder shall pay the Bid Documents based on the table below. Proof of payment shall be presented prior to submission of Bids.

- 7. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB** Clause 14.
- 8. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the office address indicated below on or before 07 December 2022 12:00 PM. Bid will be opened in the presence of the Bidder limited to only one representative, who chooses to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.
