CONTINUATION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MC NO.

2012-03

In the best interest of the service and pending full implementation of MARINA Memorandum Circular Nos. MD-2023-01¹ and MD-2020-07², be advised that MC No. 2012-03³ shall continue to be implemented until 30 June 2024 or until full implementation of MC Nos. MD-2023-01 and MD-2020-07, except for the educational requirements for examination where MC Nos. MD-2023-01 and MD-2020-07 shall apply.

MARINA will continue to issue Certificate of Marine Profession (CMP), CMP ID and will issue Notice of Passing to candidates after passing such an examination.

Further, please be guided on the licenses and limitations provided for deck and engine departments on Annex 1 to this Advisory.

This Advisory shall take effect immediately.
