SUBJECT: NOTICE TO ALL PHILIPPINE OVERSEAS SHIPPING

COMPANIES

With respect to MARINA Memorandum Circular No. 58 governing the Implementation of the United Security Council Resolution 670 (1990) and 661 (1990) on the prohibition of all Philippine registered vessels from training in Iraq trade embargo in Kuwait, attention of all Philippine overseas shipping companies and other maritime entities is being invited on the advise of the Department of Foreign Affairs regarding the "Oil for Food Swap: Process which allows merchant ships United Nations member countries to sail/ trade in all Iraqi ports for the purpose of transporting food in exchange of Iraqi oil.

Memorandum Circular Nos. 58 and 58-A shall continue to be in effect and provisions thereof shall still be incorporated among the post-approval conditions on all approvals for registrations of ships applications.
