SUBJECT: SECOND ADDENDUM TO THE AGREEMENT GOVERNING THE

DELEGATION OF STATUTORY CERTIFICATION SERVICES FOR VESSELS REGISTERED IN THE PHILIPPINES ENGAGED IN INTERNATIONAL VOYAGES BETWEEN THE MARITIME INDUSTRY AUTHORITY AND THE RECOGNIZED ORGANIZATIONS IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MARITIME

LABOUR CONVENTION, 2006

Pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 474 and Executive Order No. 125, as amended, and for the proper implementation of the Maritime Labour Convention, 2006 (MLC 2006) specifically Regulation 5.1 on the Flag State Responsibilities of MLC 2006, notice is hereby given that the Maritime Industry Authority, as the Flag State Administration delegates to Recognized Organizations (ROs) to perform in its behalf, the following functions:

- 1. Approval of a Maritime Labour Certificate (MLC) and Declaration of Maritime Labour Compliance (DMLC) Part II;
- 2. Approval of drawings and specifications according to Reg. 4.1 of the Second Addendum, including New Building Plans of Ships;
- 3. Verification of compliance of ships;
- 4. Verification that rectification of deficiencies that has been made in seafarer's working and living conditions on-board ships; and/or
- 5. Issuance and endorsement of interim/full term MLC AND DMLC.
