SUBJECT: REVISED CHART OF ACCOUNTS

In line with the current effort of this Authority in instituting greater transparency in the recording of shipping and cargo handling operations in the financial account of domestic water transport providers, a revised format of the Annual Financial Report of Operations is hereby introduced.

All concerned are hereby directed to adhere to the revised format as herein attached and forms an integral part of this Advisory.

Shipping cargo-handling, and other related transactions starting April 2003 should be recorded in the manner as herein prescribed without precluding the recording of such transactions from January .2003 March, 2003 in the said manner. Be advised that the revised format of the Annual Financial Report of Operations shall be strictly implemented through a Memorandum Circular to be issued subsequently.

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# UNIFORM CHART OF ACCOUNTS FOR ALL MARINA-ACCREDITED DOMESTIC SHIPPING ENTERPRISES

This char Account and the subsequent proforma Income and balance Sheet Statements contain the minimum requirements that have to be followed by all MARINA-accredited domestic shipping enterprises in order to attain some degree of uniformity in their accounting procedures as well as in the presentation of financial operating results.

# A. OPERATING REVENUES:

- 1. <u>Freight Revenues</u> Revenue from carriage of cargo or freight charges.
- 2. <u>Passenger Revenue</u> Revenue from carriage of passengers, passenger terminal fee, the refund and revalidation of passenger tickets, the provisions for meals, beddings, excess baggage charge.
- 3. Revenue from Vessel Charter Revenue receivable by the company under contract for the charter of its vessels as well as slot rentals to other parties.
- 4. Other Vessels Revenue All other income earned segregated as follows:
  - Canteen sales
  - Use of other facilities on board
  - Carriage of mail
  - Cargo handling
  - Storage
  - Others

### B. VESSEL OPEATING EXPENSES:

- <u>Fuel</u> Includes all fuel used on board the vessels composed of the following:
  - Bunker
  - Diesel Fuel
  - Special Fuel Oil
- 2. <u>Lubricants</u> This account refers to the cost of lubricating oils used by the vessels.

- 3. <u>Vessels Depreciation on Cost</u> This account shows the depreciation charges on the cost of all depreciable vessels, any improvements on thereon, vessels equipment, as well as any improvements on leased vessels.
- Vessel Depreciation On Appraisal Increment This refers to the depreciation charges on all appraisal increment on the cost of vessels and any improvement thereon.
- 5. <u>Drydocking, Repairs and Maintenance</u> This account includes all materials and labor expended in keeping the vessels seaworthy and operations.
- 6. **Stevedoring** This account includes all charges in connection with the vessel's loading and unloading cargo, and stowing inside hatches, compartments and on-deck open spaces.
- 7. <u>Salaries and Wages</u> These are expenses for salaries, wages and overtime pay for vessel officers and crew including the thirteenth month pay directly hired by the shipping line.
- 8. <u>Contracted Services</u> These are expenses for services rendered by outside contractors, segregated as follows:
  - a. Ship management
  - b. Crewing
  - c. Janitorial
  - d. Security
  - e. Others
- 9. <u>Food and Subsistence</u> This account includes all expenses in food for passengers and crew members.
- 10. <u>Commission Expenses</u> All amounts payable as commission to booking offices and agencies are to be shown in this account.
- 11. <u>Insurance</u> This represents insurance premiums to cover vessels, cargo and passengers segregated as follows:
  - a. Protection and Indemnity Premiums
  - b. Hull Insurance Premiums
  - c. Cargo Insurance premiums
- 12. <u>Supplies Used</u> This expense includes the cost of all deck, engine, and steward supplies used for the vessel's operation such paints, cables, wires, life jackets, waste cotton, kitchenware, linen, cost of laundry, toiletries, and other consumables segregated as follows:

- a. Deck and Engine Supplies
- b. Steward Supplies
- 13. <u>Water</u> This expense is for the cost of water supplies to the vessel.
- 14. <u>Pilotage Hire Expense</u> This shall refer to the conduction of vessels into and undocking, shifting and tug assistance.
