TO : ALL SHIPPING COMPANIES OPERATING SHIPS IN THE INTERNATIONAL VOYAGES AND OTHER MARITIME ENTITIES CONCERNED

SUBJECT : RECOGNIZED SECURITY ORGANIZATIONS IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE INTERNATIONAL SHIP AND PORT FACILITY SECURITY (ISPS) CODE

Pursuant to the 2002 amendments of the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS), 1974, Particularly on the provisions of chapter XI-2 and port facility Security (ISPS) Code which shall take effect on 01 July 2004 to cover ships engaged in the international trade including passenger ships, high-speed ferries, cargo ships 500 gross tons and above and mobile offshore drilling units, notice is hereby given that the Maritime Industry Authority has authorized the following internationally Accredited Classification societies as recognized security Organizations (RSOs) to approved ship security plans (SSP) or its amendments, verify and certify compliance by ships with requirements of chapter XI-2 and Part A of the ISPS Code, issue and endorse interim/full term International ship Security certificate (ISSC) in behalf of the administration:

3.	Det Norske Veritas	(DNV)
4.	Germanischer Lloyd	(GL)
5.	Lloyds Register of Shipping	(LR)

7.	Hellenic Register of Shipping	(HRS)
8.	Korean Register of Shipping	(KR)
