OWNERS/OPERATORS AND ALL CONCERNED

SUBJECT: SPECIAL AUTHORITY TO OPERATE PASSENGER AND/OR CARGO

LINER SHIPS DURING HOLIDAY SEASON

Pursuant to the Public Service Act (Commonwealth Act No. 146, as amended), Presidential Decree No. 474, Executive Order 125/125-A, and Republic Act No. 9295, and to ensure safe, convenient, and uninterrupted public service during Holiday Season, shipowners/operators are enjoined to:

- 1. Avoid long queueing of passengers when buying tickets;
- 2. Sell tickets on a first come first serve basis;
- 3. Not to sell tickets onboard vessels; and,
- 4. Strictly adhere to their authorized schedule of trips. However, vessels may depart as soon as they are filled, ahead of their scheduled departure, in accordance with the requirements of Flag State Administration Advisory (FSAA) No. 38 dated 08 April 2003.

All other provisions of FSAA No. 38, not otherwise inconsistent herewith, shall remain in full force and effect.
