SHIP/s DURING MANDATORY DRYDOCKING

Notice is hereby given that, henceforth, all MARINA registered/licensed shipyards, shipbuilders and/or ship repairers (including afloat repairers) shall ensure that the ship's required repairs/work orders, resulting from and as agreed upon during the mandatory drydocking of ship/s engaged in domestic shipping operations, shall bear the name and signature of the concerned MARINA surveyor/inspector in addition to the names and signatures of the domestic shipowner/operator and the registered/licensed shipyard, shipbuilder and/or ship repairer, or their duly designated representatives, prior to the latter's actual conduct of such repair/work order on the ship.

It is understood that the concerned shipyard, shipbuilder and/or ship repairer shall reflect/indicate in their respective record book the completion of all activities attendant to such repair/work order, in reiteration of Sec. VIII.10 of MARINA Circular No. 02-2007 dated 30 August 2007.

This Advisory shall take effect immediately.
