Notice is hereby given that pursuant to **MARINA CIRCULAR No. 2012-03** on the Revised Rules in the Conduct of Examination, Issuance of Certificate of Marine Profession (CMP) and License to Seafarers onboard Domestic Ships Below 500 GT or with Engine Propulsion Power of Below 750 KW which was published in The Manila Times on 25 July 2012, **MAJOR PATRON(MAP) /MINOR PATRON (MIP)/ BOAT CAPTAIN (BC)/ MARINE DIESEL MECHANIC (MDM) LICENSES** issued by this AUTHORITY before October 2012 shall be replaced by a **Certificate of Marine Profession (CMP)** and **ID License**.

Holders of said licenses are hereby enjoined to surrender or submit their licenses to the MARINA Central Office or to any of its Regional Offices on the schedule specified below.

2. Passport size colored photo in appropriate uniform
3. Medical Certificate
4. Maritime Legal Affairs Office (MLAO) Clearance, as applicable
5. Previously issued license
6. Documentary stamp

MAP/MIP/BC/MDM Licenses issued prior to October 2012 shall remain valid only until September 2013.
