VEHICLE-1(KSLV-1)

Notice is hereby given to all concerned that the Republic of Korea's Science and Technology Satellite 2 (STSAT-2) aboard Korea Space Launch Vehicle-1(KSLV-1) will be launched on 26 October 2012 with reserved launch within 27 to 31 October 2012. In order to ensure safe navigation and protection of life at sea, most particularly the fishing vessels within and near the coordinates of the anticipated impact areas of debris of STSAT-2 within the Philippine Sea, mariners/seafarers are hereby advised to keep away from the area of the subject coordinate below:
