

Notice is hereby given that the Permanent Mission of the Philippines to the United Nations Office and other International Organizations in Geneva representing the Government of the Republic of the Philippines has deposited its instrument of ratification on Maritime Labour Convention 2006 (MLC, 2006) on 20 August 2012.

The Philippines is the 30th Member-State of the International Labour Organization (ILO) to have ratified the MLC. The ratification by the Philippines enables the Convention to come into effect as binding international law on 20 August 2013.
