ABOARD KOREA SPACE LAUNCH VEHICLE-1 (KSLV-1)

BETWEEN 15 TO 30 NOVEMBER 2012

Notice is hereby given to all concerned that the Science and Technology Satellite 2 (STSAT-2) aboard Korea Space Launch Vehicle-1(KSLV-1) of the Republic of Korea is re-scheduled for launching on or between 15 to 30 November 2012. In order to ensure safe navigation and protection of life at sea, most particularly the fishing vessels within and near the coordinates of the anticipated impact areas of debris of STSAT-2 within the Philippine Sea, mariners/seafarers in reiteration of MARINA Advisory No. 2012-18, are advised to avoid passing through the following areas with the given coordinates, as follows:
