
SUBJECT : PILOT TESTING OF THE ENHANCED SPECIAL PROCESSING
WINDOW/EXPRESS LANE (E-SPWEL) INVOLVING
APPLICATIONS FROM SHIP ACQUISITION UP TO THE
ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE (CPC)

Notice is hereby given that effective **17 February 2014 to 31 July 2014**, the Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA) will be pilot testing an Enhanced Special Processing Window/Express Lane (E-SPWEL) involving applications from ship acquisition (importation and bareboat charter) up to the issuance of Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC), pursuant to Republic Act No. 9485, otherwise known as the "Anti-Red Tape Act of 2007".

The pilot testing of the E-SPWEL shall be applicable only at the MARINA Central Office and guidelines are provided under **MARINA Administrative Order No. 01-14 Series of 2014 dated 27 January 2014** (*Copy is available in the MARINA website: marina.gov.ph*).
