PILOT TESTING OF THE ENHANCED SPECIAL PROCESSING WINDOW/EXPRESS LANE (E-SPWEL) INVOLVING APPLICATIONS FROM SHIP ACQUISITION UP TO THE ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE (CPC)

Notice is hereby given that effective 17 February 2014 to 31 July 2014, the Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA) will be pilot testing an Enhanced Special Processing Window/Express Lane (E-SPWEL) involving applications from ship acquisition (importation and bareboat charter) up to the issuance of Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC), pursuant to Republic Act No. 9485, otherwise known as the "Anti-Red Tape Act of 2007".

The pilot testing of the E-SPWEL shall be applicable only at the MARINA Central Office and guidelines are provided under MARINA Administrative Order No. 01-14 Series of 2014 dated 27 January 2014 (Copy is available in the MARINA website: marina.gov.ph).
