SUBJECT

ADOPTION OF MEASURES FOR HEIGHTENED AWARENESS AND PREVENTION OF MIDDLE EAST RESPIRATORY SYNDROME - CORONA VIRUS (MERS-CoV)

In line with the instruction of the Office of the President to the Department of Health (DOH) and all other Government Agencies to create a heightened awareness among the public on the Middle East Respiratory Syndrome – Corona Virus (MERS-CoV) and to put up measures to prevent the spread of the same, all domestic shipowners/operators and all others concerned are hereby directed to observe the following:

- 1. Provide on board ships the necessary sanitary supplies and facilities;
- Provide the riding public information on MERS-CoV and proper sanitary and precautionary measures to be observed to avoid the possibility of infection (i.e. exercise of proper hand-washing procedure, covering mouth when coughing or sneezing, etc.);
- Ensure the availability of personnel who can provide immediate medical assistance to infected passengers or those who exhibit the symptoms of the disease;
- 4. Make available to the riding public contact information for concerns and emergency calls relative to MERS-CoV. For this purpose, the following contact information may be disseminated:
