STREAMLINING OF POST APPROVAL DOCUMENTS PRIOR TO CLEARANCE FOR SHIPS REGISTRATION UNDER

PHILIPPINE FLAG OF THE DOMESTIC SHIPPING SERVICE

The Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA), in line with its effort to simplify the processing and issuance of MARINA Certificate of Philippine Registration to imported ships, submission of Certificate of Payment (COP) and Certificate of Conversion (COC) issued by the Bureau of Customs (BOC) are no longer required.

In lieu thereof, import entry declaration and any proof of payment of customs duties and taxes, due the subject ship bearing the final assessment of the BOC will be accepted.
