To : All Shipowners/Bareboat Charterers/Ship Operators/Ship Managers with Philippine-Registered Ships Engaged in International Voyages, Recognized Organizations, Port State Control Authorities and Other Concerned Entities

Subject : Revised Procedure for Urgent Requests, Applications or Filing of Reports Involving Philippine-Registered Ships During Weekends, Non-Working Days and After Office Hours

In the interest of the service, and with reference to Special Order No. 1,033-13, series of 2013, dated 03 December 2013 issued by the Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA), notice is hereby given of the revised procedure for urgent applications, requests or filing of reports received during weekends, non-working days and after office hours:

I. MARITIME ATTACHÉ

For purposes of this Advisory, the public is hereby informed of the establishment of the Maritime Attaché Post in London, with the following contact details:

When calling after official working hours in Manila, the concerned owner/operator/representative of the Philippine-registered ships may directly contact the Maritime Attaché in London.

II. COVERAGE:

This Advisory covers the following applications, requests and reports received during weekends, non-working days and after office hours, involving all Philippine-registered ships plying international waters:

 Dispensation Permit in case of death or injury to the crew onboard; extension of servicing of lifeboat/liferaft, emergency drydocking and other similar and analogous circumstances.

- 2. Letter authorization to Recognized Organization (RO) under the following circumstances:
 - a. if there is an accident during the voyage of the Philippine-registered overseas ships;
 - b. detention of Philippine-registered ships by other Port State Control authorities;
 - c. malfunction of the ship's equipment including, but not limited to, defective gyro compass, alarm monitoring system, radio equipment or oil water incinerator;
 - d. damaged liferaft or lifeboat;
 - e. other deficiencies that may occur during the ship's voyage; and,
 - f. other similar and analogous circumstances.
- 3. Incident Reports with regard to Philippine-registered ships.

III. REQUIREMENTS

Filing of request/report via email including, but not limited to: name of the concerned shipping company, name of ship, reason/s for the request, duration, name of RO, itinerary of the ship and other relevant information necessary to the request.

IV. PROCEDURE

1. Urgent requests/reports may be directly coursed through:

a. For dispensation permits, extension of servicing of lifeboat/liferaft and emergency drydocking, and other similar analogous circumstances.
