

## **MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 25-B**

**TO : ALL FISHING OPERATION AND OTHERS CONCERNED**

**SUBJECT : ONE (1) YEAR MORATORIUM ON FISHING VESSEL.  
IMPORTATION/ CHARTERING GUIDELINES UNDER  
MC NO. 25**

Please be informed that the Maritime Industry Board in its meeting on April 23, 1985 has approved a one (1) year moratorium on fishing vessel importation/chartering requirements under Memorandum Circular No.25. In view thereof, the following rules on the importation/ chartering of fishing vessels are hereby adopted:

1. That the minimum size limit allowable for fishing vessels for importation/ chartering shall be twenty- five gross ton (25 G. T.)
2. That the age of the fishing vessels shall not be more than fifteen (15) years at the date of importation and charter.
3. That the foregoing size and age limitation shall only be effective for a period of one (1) year from issuance hereof, unless an extension is found necessary for the relief and recovery of the fishing industry.

MARINA Memorandum Circulars Nos. 10 , 21 , 21-A , 22 , 25 and 25-A in so far as they are not inconsistent with this Circular shall remain in full force and effect.

This Circular shall take effect immediately.
