SUBJECT: AMENDING MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO.58 ON THE

MEASURES ADOPTED GOVERNING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE UNITED NATIONS SECIRITY COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS 670 (1990) AND 661

(1990)

In view of the formal cessation of hostilities and recent developments in the Persian Gulf Region, the trade embargo imposed on Kuwait has been lifted. As such, Memorandum Circular No. 58, particularly the measures adopted, is hereby correspondingly amended. Philippine shipping companies and other maritime entities are now allowed to trade with Kuwait. However, the prohibition to trade with Iraq is still in effect.

All provisions of Memorandum Circular No.58 which are not contrary to or inconsistent with this Memorandum Circular shall remain in full force and effect.

This Memorandum shall take effect immediately.
