SUBJECT: REVISED SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES

Pursuant to the provisions of Presidential Decree No.474, the Public Service Act (C.A. No. 146), as amended, Executive Order No.125/125-A, Executive Order No.292 (Administrative Code of 1987), Batas Pambansa Blg. 325, the General Provisions of the general Appropriations Act (GAA) and in compliance with Executive Order No. 197, s.2000, directing all departments, bureaus, commissions, agencies, offices and instrumentalities of the national government, including government-owned or controlled corporations, to increase their rates of fees and charges by not less than 20 percent, E.O. No. 218 and the implementing Rules and regulations for E.O. Nos. 197 and 218 under DOF-DBM Joint Circular No. 2000-2, the Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA) shall collect and impose the adjusted rates of Fees and Charges listed in "ANNEX A" hereof.

This Memorandum shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication once in a newspaper of general circulation.
