

SUBJECT : ISSUANCE OF CEASE AND DESIST ORDER TO SHIPS
INVOLVED IN REPEATED SERIOUS MARITIME
INCIDENTS/ACCIDENTS.

To ensure that all Philippine registered ships operating in domestic trade are properly maintained and operated in a safe and reliable manner, NOTICE is hereby given that any occurrence of accidents/incidents involving your vessels will be dealt with by this Authority severely. A repetition of any accidents, of serious nature, of any ships owned and/operated by the Company/Ship Owner or managed by Ship Managers will result to issuance of a cease and desist order. The order will only be lifted if this Authority is satisfied that the Company/Ship Owner or Ship Managers had put in place corrective actions or procedures to avoid the recurrence of accidents/incidents.
