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TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE BASIC MARINA ENFORCEMENT COURSE

APPROVED BUDGET FOR THE CONTRACT

The Approved Budget of the Contract for the conduct of five (5)-day training of Basic MARINA. Enforcement Course with venue and accommodation is THREE-HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND PESOS (Php 320,000.00) inclusive of taxes and other charges.

2. SCOPE AND COVERAGE OF SERVICE

2.1. Duration of Activity

The whole course shall be conducted for five (5) days of in-house training with eight (8) hour-session per day, in two (2) batches. The training will be conducted on the following

1st Batch

22-26 October 2018

2rd Batch

05-09 November 2018

2.2 Scope of the Course

The course shall be adopted from Flag State Implementation under IMO Course 3.22. which will cover the following modules that will enhance the knowledge and skills of MARINA personnel:

2.3 Participants

The course provider shall accommodate two (2) batches of twenty (20) participants per session in a classroom type arrangement. The participants are composed of MCO and MRO representatives.

The lecturer shall come from a well-established training institution and be able to discuss the topics of the course well in English language with professional expertise in facilitating the aforementioned course scope.

2.5 Certificates

Certificate of Completion shall be given to all participants who completed the course which will be signed and provided by the lecturer and/or course provider.

3. REQUIRED QUALIFICATION OF THE COURSE PROVIDER.

The course provider shall have the following qualifications:

- Must be a well-known and established training provider
- b. Could provide training course venue and accommodation for participants
- Could accommodate the requirements under the aforementioned Terms of PREFERENCE (TOR)
- As assurance, the MARINA shall provide the course provider with the Certification of Availability of Funds from the Financial Management Service.
