**TO : Domestic Shipping Companies / Operators / Charterers, Ship management Agents and all Concerned**

**SUBJECT : MANDATORY REQUIREMENT FOR REPORTING OF MARINE CASUALTY OR INCIDENT TO THE MARITIME INDUSTRY AUTHORITY (MARINA)**

Pursuant to MARINA Circular no. 2015-11 on Revised Rules and Regulations to implement a Safety Management System for Domestic Shipping and to uphold the role and responsibility of the domestic shipping companies / operators / charterers / agents in achieving and maintaining high standards of safety and marine environment protection; establishing of safeguards against identified risks; and, continuous improvement of safety management skills of personnel ashore and aboard ships, including preparation for emergencies related to both safety and marine environment protection, you are hereby directed to strictly comply with the mandatory requirement for reporting of all incidents/accidents of any type.

In case a ship is involved, the Designated Person (DP) shall report immediately its occurrence to the Enforcement Service of MARINA through its hotline **09954007336** and in writing the full particulars thereof through fastest possible means within 24 hours after the occurrence.

None compliance herewith shall provide basis for this Authority to impose fines and penalties prescribed under MARINA Circular No. 2015-11.
