ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PERMIT FOR OPERATION OF DOMESTIC SHIPS EXCLUSIVELY IN THE BRUNEI DARUSSALAM-INDONESIA-MALAYSIA-PHILIPPINES EAST

ASEAN GROWTH ARE/+ (BIMP-EAGA) ROUTES

In the interest of the service and in view of the thrust of the present government to ease the doing of business and provide efficient delivery of services to the public pursuant to Republic Act No. 11032, the following information is given in relation to the above subject:

- The MARINA Administrator, MRO IV-Palawan, MRO IX, MRO X, MRO XI and MRO XII are the only authorized signatories to Special Permit for domestic ships that will ply BIMP-EAGA routes, including the Minimum Safe Manning Certificates attendant thereto;
- Pursuant to Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Governments
  of Brunei Darussalam, Indonesia, Malaysia and the Philippines on Establishing
  and Promoting Efficient ad Integrated Sea Linkages, signed on 2 November
  2007, the following are the designated BIMP-EAGA Gateway ports and
  identified areas of connectivity:
