- 1 Life Ring at least 24inches in Diameter with 75 feet of Rope
- 1 Set minimum 3kg Anchor with Chain at least 1/3 the length of the vessel and 100 feet of Sinking Marine Rope.
- 2 Sets Mooring Lines at least 10ft Long

- Emergency Oxygen Tank
- A Dive Operator Staff Member certified in First Aid and use of Emergency Oxygen tank must be onboard for every trip.

Compliances (for all Boats in this Classification)

- Captain's License (Original copy on board)
- Passenger Manifest (1 copy to be kept on board and the other to be kept at the point of origin at the recreational boat operator's office) Or Uploaded on the Recreational Boat App.
- Weather (conditions must be safe to operate)
- Safety Orientation (to be conducted by Captain before every departure)
- Emergency Instructions (to be conducted by Captain before every departure)
