INSTALLATION OF CANVASS AWNINGS / TARPAULINS

SUBJECT TO TECHNICAL AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Pending the complete phase-out of wooden-hulled motorbancas carrying passengers, the installation of canvass awnings/tarpaulins on currently operating wooden-hulled motorbancas will be allowed but subject to the following specifications/conditions, in the interest of safety:

- The MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE LENGTH of tarpaulin/canvass to be installed shall be fifty percent (50%) of the Length Overall (LOA) of the motorbanca.
- 2. The MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE WIDTH of tarpaulin/canvass to be installed shall be eighty percent (80%) of the Breadth of the motorbanca.
- 3. The tarpaulin/canvass shall be elevated to a maximum height of 1.80 meters from the uppermost part of the side shell and spread as much as possible straight horizontally.
- 4. The angle of inclination should not be more than fifteen degrees 15 degrees from the horizontal line.
- 5. No passengers are allowed to occupy portion above the machinery space up to the aft most part.
- 6. Both sides (port and starboard) of the motorbanca should have a minimum spacing in between post of 1.50 meter and minimum size of opening which is 1.00 meter x 1.00 meter.
- 7. For motorbancas with fixed shed, it shall be elevated to a height of 1.80 meters from the uppermost part of the side shell and spread up to the moulded breadth.

All other conditions on the safety limitations of said wooden-hulled motorbancas shall continue to be observed as follows:

- 1. Passengers shall be required to wear life jackets at all times throughout the voyage.
- 2. Motorbancas shall carry passengers only up to 75% of their authorized capacity.
- 3. All operations must only be from sunrise to sunset during fair weather condition.
- 4. Motorbancas shall be equipped with distress signal equipment.

This issuance shall be without prejudice to the implementation of the Transition Plan on the Phase-in / Phase out Program of wooden-hulled motorbancas as proposed by boat cooperatives/owners of respective MARINA Regional offices.
