GUIDELINES ON THE DISPOSAL OF UNCLAIMED CERTIFICATE

OF PROFICIENCY (COP), CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY (COC)

AND CERTIFICATE OF ENDORSEMENT (COE)

Notice is hereby given to all concerned that unclaimed certificates will be disposed in accordance with the following guidelines:

- 1. The Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping Office (STCWO), this Authority, through its Certification Division (CD) and its Satellite Offices, shall secure all unclaimed certificates for a maximum period of six (6) months reckoned from the date of its issuance.
- 2. All certificates left unclaimed beyond the retention period of six (6) months shall be transferred to the MARINA Central Office General Services Division (GSD) for proper disposition.
- 3. Within the six (6) month retention period, concerned seafarers will be given two (2) notices to claim their certificates:
 - a. The first notice will be sent via Short Messaging Service (SMS) or text message to the applicant-seafarer's registered mobile number;
 - b. The second and final notice will be sent via Short Messaging Service (SMS) or text message one (1) month prior to the lapse of the six (6) month period.
- 4. After the six (6) month retention period, concerned seafarers will be required to reapply and pay for the new certificate/s.

This Advisory shall take effect immediately after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
