OWNERS AND OPERATORS, STAKEHOLDERS,
SEAFARERS AND ALL CONCERNED

SUBJECT : Further Amendment of MARINA Advisory No. 2020-43 on the
Provisional Extension of SIRB/SRB Validity for Seafarers
Currently Onboard Ships Operating Both in Domestic and
Overseas During COVID 19 Pandemic

In the interest of the service, and with reference to MARINA Advisory No. 2020-43 dated 05 June 2020 issued by the Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA) which provides that:

"All Seafarer's Record Book (SRB) or Seafarer's Identification and Record Book (SIRB) expiring between 01 June 2020 to 30 June 2020 shall be provisionally extended until 31 December 2020.....xx.

Taking into account the foregoing very short period of provisional extension stated under MARINA Advisory No. 2020-43, notice is hereby given of its further amendment, to provide as follows:

"All Seafarer's Record Book (SRB) or Seafarer's Identification and Record Book (SIRB) expiring between 13 March 2020 to 31 July 2020 shall be provisionally extended until 31 December 2020, and shall be deemed valid without filing for an application for its renewal at the MARINA.

xxx."

All concerned manning/crewing agencies and shipping companies are directed to submit electronic report to MARINA, duly signed by the authorized company representative or by the Master of the vessel. The report must attach a copy of the certification of extension issued by the shipowners/operators, crewing agencies or ship Master to their crewmembers/seafarers following the format in Annex 1, which may be downloaded at this email address mds@marina.gov.ph.

All other Advisories inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed accordingly.

This Advisory shall take effect immediately.
