TO : ALL DOMESTIC SHIPPING COMPANIES, SHIP OWNERS/OPERATORS/CHARTERERS AND OTHER CONCERNED

SUBJECT : RULES/GUIDELINES ON THE POSTING OF PROPOSED SCHEDULE OF TRIPS

To ensure that the riding public/shippers have ample time to plan ahead their trips/voyages/shipments, particularly during the Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) pandemic and the onset of weather disturbances causing delays in shipping operations/schedules and port operations, and for them to be fully aware of any changes in sailing schedule of trips of concerned domestic shipping companies, the following rules/guidelines are hereby implemented:

1. Concerned domestic shipping companies/operators shall be allowed to prepare, propose and observe a non-CPC/temporary schedule of trips for a period of ninety (90) days, subject to filing of an application for Special Permit (SP);
2. The proposed ninety (90)-day schedule of trips shall be posted/circulated by the company through all available online means or by any other information/digital platform, (e.g website, Facebook page, Twitter, Messenger, Viber, etc) or by posting at conspicuous places at the port terminals/premises, for information of the public, at least five (5) days prior to the filing of the application for SP;
3. Upon filing of the application, MARINA shall issue a ninety (90)-day SP per issuance, allowing the temporary observance of the proposed schedule of trips, subject to the payment of fees and charges amounting to a total of three (3) months;
4. Any changes in the schedules within the validity of the SP due to unforeseen circumstances, shall be subject to a letter-notification to MARINA, citing reasons for such changes. This letter-notification shall include the catch-up schedule for the observance of the remaining trips in the SP;

5. The shipping companies/operators shall continue to post any changes/updates in the schedules;
6. This Advisory shall not in any way prejudice the existing CPC schedules; and,
7. All other rules, regulations and conditions, otherwise inconsistent herewith, shall remain in full force and effect.

This MARINA Advisory shall take effect immediately and shall remain valid and subsisting until otherwise revoked/amended/modified or until further notice.
