TO : ALL SHIPPING COMPANIES, SHIP OPERATORS, SHIP CHARTERERS AND ALL CONCERNED

SUBJECT : HARMONIZATION ON THE SYSTEM OF SURVEY AND CERTIFICATION OF PHILIPPINE-REGISTERED DOMESTIC SHIPS

In line with the implementation of Memorandum Circular No. 203 and to provide a system to harmonize the survey/inspection and issuance of Load Line Certificate and ship safety certificate of Philippine-registered ships in domestic trade, the following notice is hereby given;

1. All Philippine-registered domestic ships issued with cargo ship safety certificates shall have a validity of not more than **five (5) years** subject to annual endorsement within three (3) months before or after the anniversary date of its annual survey, co-terminus with the Load Line Certificate with the following reckoning dates:
 - (a) For existing ships, the reckoning for the renewal of Load Line Certificate and Ship Safety Certificate shall be the date of the undocking of ships during its mandatory dry-docking of the five year dry-docking period; and
 - (b) For newly constructed ships, the reckoning for the issuance of Load Line Certificate and Ship Safety Certificate shall be the date of the completion of the initial survey.
2. No extension shall be granted after the five (5) years validity of Load Line Certificate.
3. The vessel shall be required to undergo dry-docking twice within the five (5) years dry-docking cycle as required under MC No. 152, and its subsequent amendments. Extension of the conduct of intermediate dry-docking of vessel shall be in accordance with the rules specified under MC No. 152, and its subsequent amendments.
4. Passenger Ship Safety Certificates shall be issued to all passenger ships valid not more than one (1) year with the same reckoning dates specified on paragraph 1 (a) and 1 (b) of this Advisory.

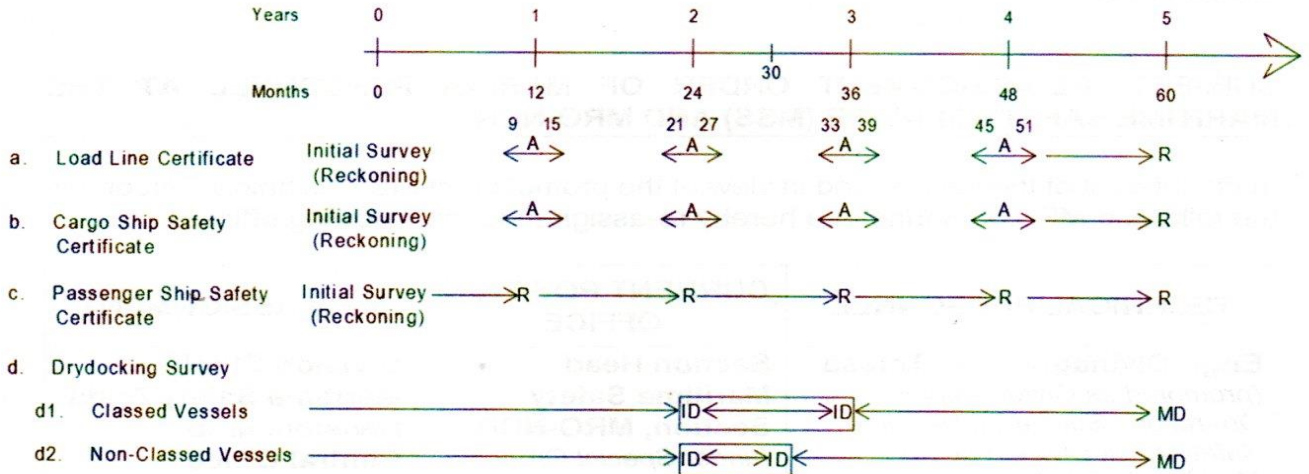

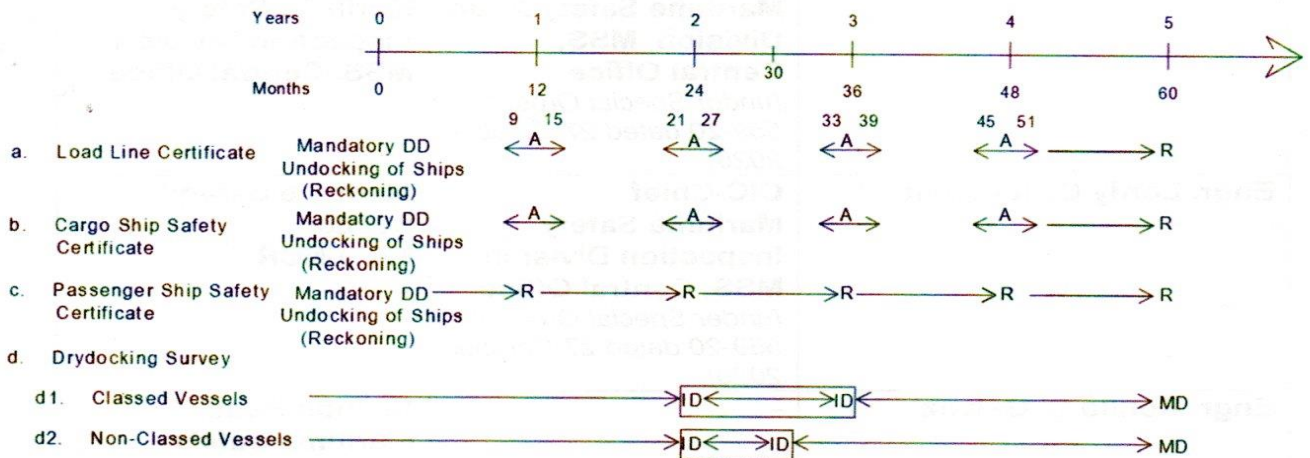
