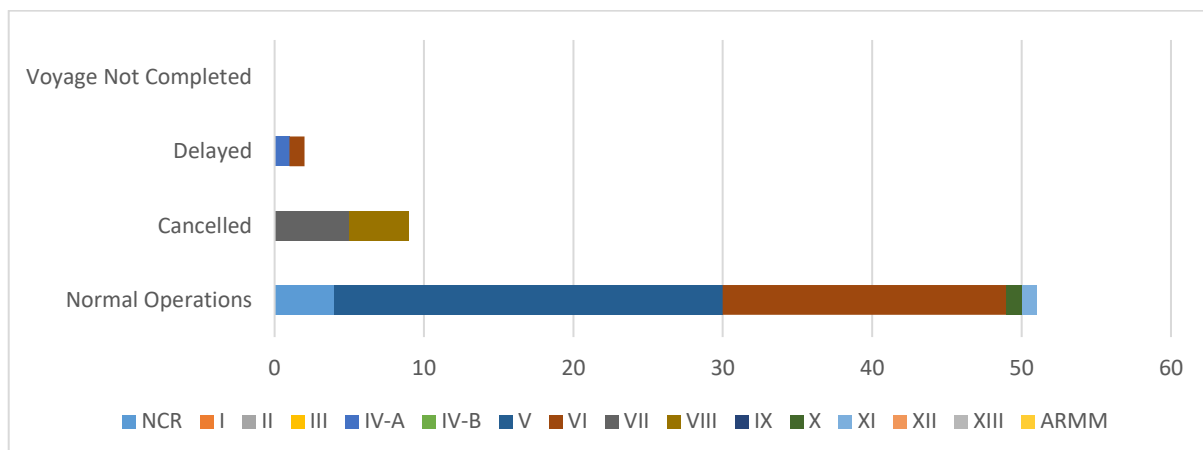


I. STATUS OF SHIPPING OPERATIONS NATIONWIDE



On 10/10/2021, there were 62 passenger and cargo shipping operations conducted wherein 51 or 82% were completed in accordance with their Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC).

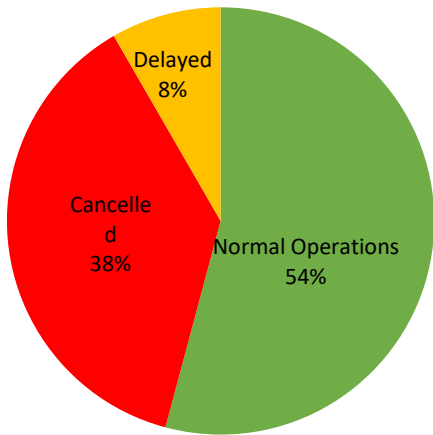
Out of the 51 operations completed under normal conditions, the reported movements were mostly in the Bicol Region at 51% and Western Region at 37%.

Meanwhile, 15% of the passenger and cargo shipping operations were cancelled, all due to the community quarantine measures imposed by the different local government units governing the ships' ports of destination. Mostly affected were operations in the Central Visayas and Eastern Visayas Regions.

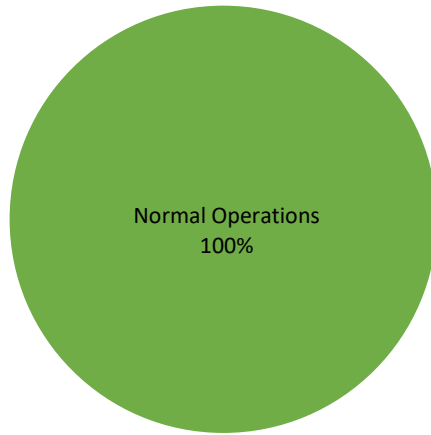
Two (2) passenger ships or 8% encountered delays due to the additional measures adopted in view of COVID-19 such as temperature screening and inspections.

Lastly, no shipping operations were not completed at the time of reporting.

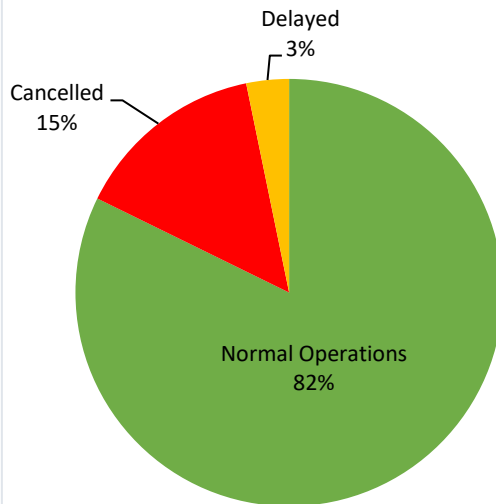

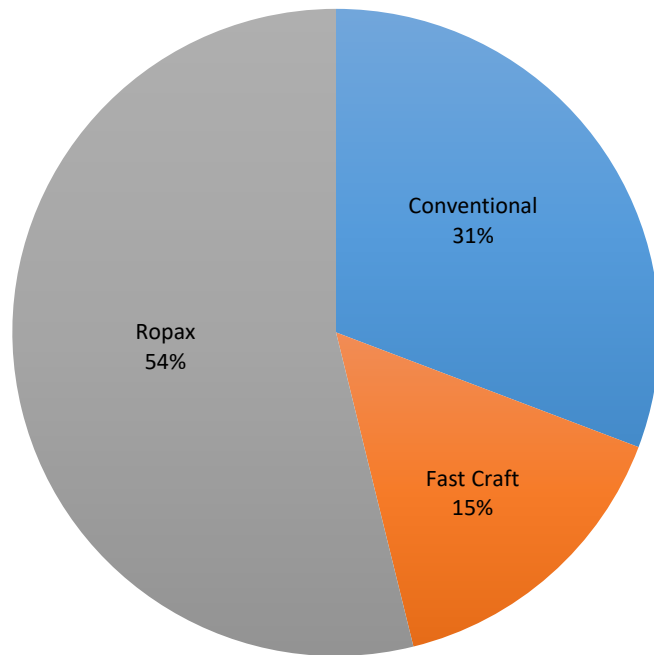
**CARGO
