TO : ALL SHIPPING COMPANIES, SHIP OPERATORS, SHIP CHARTERERS AND ALL CONCERNED


SUBJECT : LIFTING OF POLICY LIMITING PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION ACCESS TO VACCINATED POPULATION IN THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION

Pursuant to the directive of the Department of Transportation dated 01 February 2022 and considering that the National Capital Region has been placed under Alert Level 2, Notice is hereby given to all concerned that the "**No Vaccination, No Ride Policy**" in the operation of maritime transport particularly on board passenger ships is **no** longer in effect.

However, approved standardized travel protocols for sea transport shall be strictly implemented as follows:

1. Mandatory wearing of facemask;
2. Prohibit passengers from talking and unnecessary phone calls;
3. Banning of food for category 2 vessels (less than four hours travel time);
4. Social distancing shall still be observed at all times especially in common areas such as canteen, lounge, open deck and the likes. Mass gathering on-board is likewise prohibited;
5. Appropriate and sufficient ventilation system must be installed to reduce the risk of virus circulation within enclosed accommodation/spaces;
6. Disinfection of common areas as well as toilets after disembarkation of passengers; and,
7. To maintain 1 meter distance apart while passengers are queuing during boarding and disembarkation.
